General Format:

Author. *Title of Source*. Version (edition, if applicable), Publisher, Publication date.

Print Book:

Dym, Clive L., and Patrick Little. *Engineering Design: A Project-Based Introduction*. 2nd ed., John Wiley, 2004.

Book with 3 or More Authors:

Byatt, Andrew, et al. *The Blue Planet: A Natural History of the Oceans*. DK, 2001.

Edited Book:

Haerens, Margaret, editor. *Illegal Immigration*. Greenhaven Press, 2006.

Chapter from an Anthology:

Author. "Title of Chapter." *Title of Anthology*, editor, Publisher, Publication Year, Location (Page range).

More, Hannah. "The Black Slave Trade: A Poem." *British Women Poets of the Romantic Era*, edited by Paula R.

Feldman, Johns Hopkins UP, 1997, pp. 472-82.

eBook:

Author. *Title of Source*. Version (edition, if applicable), Publisher, Publication date. *Container (Database)*,

Location (Permalink or URL – omit http://).

Library Database Articles (Journals, Magazines, Newspapers)

General Format:

Author. "Title of Source." *Title of Container (Publication)*, Number (volume, issue) included for journals only,

Publication date, Location (page range). *Title of Container (Database)*, Location (DOI, Permalink, URL).

Journal Article with DOI:

Journal Article without DOI:

Articles in Print

Printed articles use the same citation format as online articles, but **do not** include the second container (database name) or second location (DOI, Permalink, URL).

General Format:

Author. "Title of Source." *Title of Container (Publication)*, Number (volume, issue) included for journals only,
Publication date, Location (page range).

Print Newspaper Article:

Levy, Philip I., and Christine A. McDaniel. "A Better Way to Look at Trade Deals." *Investor's Business Daily*, 24
June 2016, p. 1.

Web Pages

General Format:

Author. "Title of Source (Web Page)." *Title of Container (Overall Web Site)*, Publisher (omit if it is the same as
the overall Web site), Publication Date (or last update), Location (URL - omit http://).

Web Page, Publisher Same as Web Site:
